LIVE-IN INFORMATION

- ✎ Students must pay \$10 cash to Mā Emery by Wednesday morning every week for kai
- ✎ Students will get dinner at every live-in
- ✎ Students will be released for sports training for a maximum of 3 hours – If they have sports trainings. Please be reminded that this will impact their chances of performing or keeping their positions in rows. Parents must email Mā Mihaere - mmihaere-marshall@ngatapuwaee.school.nz - to register absence for trainings by Wednesday mornings.
- ✎ Students must bring all bedding, appropriate changes and toiletries. It is imperative that students bring sheets! It is unhygienic for them to sleep on our mattresses without a sheet. We must ensure that our facilities are kept in good hygienic working order for any ope we have staying at Kura.
- ✎ All students will take part in a health and fitness regime; therefore they must always bring runners to live-ins.
