- Depart: Monday 18th September departing at 12:25pm ~ Air New Zealand
Return: Friday 22nd September arriving at 4:45pm ~ Air New Zealand
- Please note that for departure our group must be there 2 hours before we fly. Specific information will be sent out at a later date.
- All names have been submitted to the airline for ticket allocation.
- Please note curriculum work is being closely monitored and the list of students can change depending on their attendance and work ethic at school.

🔔 **LUGGAGE INFORMATION**

- Each student has a 23kg checked luggage allowance.
- All students **MUST** have a suitcase. Please do not send them with a sports bag or duffle bag. Suitcases are much easier to pack into the buses and wheel around.
- Students must be mindful of the weight of their suitcases and remember that their No.1's are to be packed into their suitcases also.

- Carry-on – Students can have a SMALL SIDE BAG to hold cash, cards, wallets or phones. Nothing bigger than an A5 paper. Students are not permitted to have backpacks.

- All students must bring a pair of BLACK runners for travelling uniform.
- All students must have a Kura beanie.
