# WAKA AMA NATIONALS, ROTORUA 2025 Friday 24th January 2025

Tēnā koutou e ngā Mātua,

Your child has been selected to represent Te Kura Māori o Ngā Tapuwae at the 2025 Waka Ama Nationals to be held in Rotorua from the 23rd March – 29th March.

The national event will be held at Lake Tikitapu (Blue Lakes). Our accommodation will be Cleveland Motel, 113-119 Lake Road, Koutu, Rotorua 3010 We will depart school on Sunday the 23<sup>rd</sup> March and your child will be expected to arrive at school on time before 8.30am. We will return on Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> March at approximately 3pm. However, we will have the students contact you on our journey home.

The cost for this national campaign is \$500.00 per student which has been heavily subsidized by the tumuaki and our board of trustees. We appreciate their support. This will help to pay for paddler fees, food, transport and accommodation for the week. Students will require the school tracksuit and training attire for this trip which are additional at a total of \$225 if they require every item so please place your order no later than Tuesday 28th January to ensure they are well equipped for this trip.

# Uniform requirements:

- ➤ New school tracksuit = \$140
- > 1x Race top = \$60
- ➤ Beanie = \$25

Students must ensure they pack clothes, towels and toiletries for the stay. Linen is provided from accommodation.
