Your child has been selected to represent our Kura and begin preparing for this years 2021 Senior Waka Ama Regatta that is scheduled to be on Saturday 27th February. We have been fortunate enough to utilise Manukau Outrigging club waka that we are truly grateful for. Trainings will run from straight after school to 5.30pm. Trainings will take place at Ian Shaw Reserve, Panama Road Mt Wellington every Tuesday and Thursday.

For the first week of February Tuesday 2nd to Friday 5th we wish to utilise the early finishes and train every day. We are hopeful that this build up to the regatta will allow our team to qualify for the NZ secondary school Waka Ama nationals.

The cost for these trainings will be \$15 for the whole duration which will cover hireage of the waka and regatta race fee. If your child requires transport the cost will be an additional \$5 which is due at the first training session. The school van has been booked and will have only one return destination back here to Kura.

Please ensure your child is well equipped with comfortable clothing, towel, paddle (if they have their own), a hat and suitable footwear as well as a large bottle of water to sip on.
