This pānui is a friendly reminder of all of the things happening over the next month:

Term 3 finishes at 12pm this Friday 27th September

This is a reminder that school finishes for the term at 12pm this Friday. It is imperative that your child is collected from school at this time if they do not catch the bus. We do not have the staff available to monitor children left here after 12:15pm. Therefore, if you cannot be here on time to pick up your child please make alternate arrangements for the day.
