You may be aware that we are hosting the Regional Ngā Manu Kōrero Speech Competition for Te Whaitua o Uenuku on Friday 30th July 2021. This is during the first week of next term. As we are expecting over 500 visitors to school we have decided that it will be best for our younger students to take the opportunity to experience Education Outside the Classroom.

As such, the following trips will take place:

- ☞ Years 1 – 3: Hippo Playground
- ☞ Years 4 – 6: Auckland Museum
- ☞ Years 7 – 10: MOTAT

The buses will leave by 8:40am so it is imperative that ALL students arrive by 8:30am at the latest for Karakia and Roll Call. They will also need to bring a bottle of water and extra morning tea items if they usually have them. However, our kitchen staff will organise a packed lunch including fruit and snacks for morning tea so you won't need to worry about that.

The school will also subsidise part of the costs for these trips, but we will need you to pay \$12 per child or \$30 per whānau for 3+ children to cover the remaining expenses. We ask that you return the signed permission slip and payment to school by Wednesday 28th July 2021 so we can finalise numbers.
