They will also need to be well prepared for living in for the duration of the week.

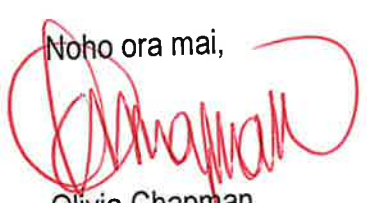
