As we draw near the end of this year's MKT campaign, it is crucial that your child attends every live-in from start to finish. We ask that your whānau prioritises Mana Kuratahi for the next two weeks until our campaign ends. Any type of absence from here onward will be detrimental to whether they take the stage on performance day. We understand that class work for some students is not up to date which is unacceptable. Please check in with your child to see if they are up to date with their mahi.

Please leave all MKT gears including tracksuits and new haka tees for performance week only so they are fresh, clean and new looking.

We will now be banning snacks and lollies for the remainder of the campaign. All students are well-fed and fueled with healthier alternatives here at Kura to help them throughout practice times.

## PERFORMANCE DATE / TICKETS

We will be performing at 3pm on Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> of November at Te Pai Centre 31-35 Te Pai Place, Henderson, Auckland.

Lastly, here are some notes from the Mana Kuratahi Organising Committee for whānau:

- Parking is limited to onsite or roadside parking on surrounding streets, with paid parking available at Trust Stadium. Spaces are first come, first served.
- No Parking in Nearby Businesses: Please avoid parking in spaces belonging to nearby businesses, as they will tow unauthorised vehicles.
- Walk-In Entrance: Entry is via Clemway Place.
- Door Sales: \$5 for ages 5 and up. Kaumātua and children under 5 are free.
- Food Available: Kai and various stalls will be set up onsite. No food or drink is allowed
