We would like to congratulate your child on being selected to represent our Kura at the 2024 National Secondary Schools Kapahaka Competitions in Nelson. Please see the most up to date information for the trip set out below.

CONFIRMED COST OF TRIP

- ✦ **\$950** – Includes 8 nights' accommodation, return flights, all transfers, all meals
- ✦ **1st Installment** - \$450 due 22nd March 2024
- ✦ **Final Payment** - \$500 due 24th May 2024

NB: This trip has been heavily subsidized by the funding efforts of the Kura.

COMPULSORY UNIFORM

- ✦ Kura Tracksuit – Can be paid (\$140) and ordered at the Kura office. Orders and payments must be made by the 19th of February. The next order will not be placed until August.

TRIP OUTLINE

- ✦ **Departing Flight** – Saturday 22nd June 2024
 1. There are 2 separate flights – Details will be given later.
 2. Please scan through a current/valid identification document (Passport/Driver's License/Birth Certificate) for your child to smason@ngatapuwaee.school.nz. A photo ID is preferred but not essential.
- ✦ **Pōhiri** – Monday 24th June 2024 @ Trafalgar Centre
- ✦ **Performance Day** – Tuesday 25th June @ approximately 10am
- ✦ **Finals Day** – Friday 28th June
- ✦ **Return Flight** – Sunday 30th June 2024
 1. The group will return on 2 separate flights.

ACCOMMODATION

- ✦ **Palms Nelson** – This is the site of accommodation for our group for the entire trip and is situated approximately 300m from the Trafalgar Centre
