Parents will be informed about the estimated time or return via text. There is no cost for this trip however, they might want spending money for lunch on the way back. Prior to this excursion they will do preparation activities at Kura on Wednesday 30th July and will be able to arrive to Kura in comfortable mufti clothes.

All camping gear will be provided such as sleeping mats, sleeping bags, tents and utensils. Students will need to pack warm clothes (waterproof if they have any), walking shoes/boots, towel, small toilet bag with toiletries. We also have hiking back packs if necessary.
