Tēnā koutou e ngā mātua,

We would like to confirm that your child will be performing at the Te Ahurea Tino Rangatiratanga Festival next Saturday 14th October, here at our kura.

Ahurea details -

Their stage time is 1.30pm, therefore, could you please ensure your child arrives to kura **no later than 12.15pm** and meets Mā Cook and Mā Ripia at the back school gate on Buckland Road.

What they will need:

Each student to be dressed in a white tee and black bottoms

Girls – black skirt (knee-length)

Boys – black shorts (just above knee-length) + tidy, brushed hair

Long hair – please have top half in a mid-ponytail and the bottom half out

Water bottle (named)

*Please ensure they have eaten before they arrive.

If you would like to take photos with our kapa after their performance, please join us on the side wall of the gym, under our giant Kura logo.

As there is no live-in for this performance, we ask that a parent or caregiver collects your child **from the Tari area at 3pm sharp** as we will not release them into the mass crowd by themselves.

Baked Goods Stall at Ahurea –

Mana Kuratahi will be holding the Kura Baked Goods + Sweets stall on both days of the Ahurea Festival. Remembering that our lofty goal is to raise money to help cover our travelling uniforms. Therefore we are asking whānau to reach out to aunts, uncles, nannies, koros to help with your contribution with eg. a cake or rēwena each, to koha on your behalf.

Boys – to donate kai for Friday

Girls – to donate kai for Saturday

We are also looking to confirm our stall lead/s for both days, as well as kaimahi please as our kaiako will be out in other key roles for the event.

Final wānanga details -

The dates for our final wānanga have been updated as follows:

Bring live-in gears to kura 8.30am start in Te Hau Kotahi (gym)	Wānanga finishes at 3pm Pick up as per normal or bus home

Kai details -

Each student will need to bring \$10 cash, please hand in to Mā Koti.

What to bring:

- blanket, pillow, sheet (*Please wash bedding before/after each live-in)
- 2 changes of comfortable clothes
- sports shoes / sliders
- pyjamas
- towel
- warm jacket
- toiletries – soap, shampoo, toothbrush etc
- water bottle (named)
- own practice poi (girls)
- phones must be signed in/out at the Tari as per normal school protocol

Lastly, there will be no after-school practises this term. All remaining practises will occur during school hours. It is imperative that your child attends school in these last few weeks of our campaign before we travel to Whakatū-Nelson.
