Students Code of Conduct

- Students are to advocate themselves and Te Kura Māori o Ngā Tapuwae with pride at all times.
- 2. Students will uphold and encourage all Te Kura Māori o Ngā Tapuwae rules at all times.
- 3. Students will arrive at school no later than 8:30am daily
- 4. Students will be well groomed and well presented in school uniform for each day
 - a) Students are to ensure that the only jewellery worn is one set of earrings (studs or sleepers) and a taonga. There are no rings, necklaces, bangles or other forms of jewellery to be worn.
 - b) Students hair is expected to be maintained and of a natural colour and if longer than shoulder length, tied back with a black or white hair tie/s.
 - c) Boys facial hair is to be cleanly shaven at all times.
 - d) Love bites or markings are not acceptable.
 - e) Inappropriate body markings/piercings are not to be visible.
- 5. Students will be punctual to each lesson of the day.
- 6. Students will exercise high standards of discipline and respect.
- 7. Students will ensure that all equipment owned by school will be treated in a correct manner at all times. Students will be held responsible for any goods they damage.
- 8. Students will treat all other students fairly and respectfully.
- 9. Students will respect all staff.
- 10. All book records should be available for each teacher. It should be legible and reader friendly.
- 11. Students will regularly celebrate the achievements of peers.
- 12. Students' personal belongings should be kept at home or safe at all times.
- 13. All students are to acknowledge the student "hierarchy' i.e. Prefects/Y13/Y12 etc / girls before boys etc.
- 14. Students are to be active participants in all whare duties and activities.
- 15. Students will produce a legible note of reason when out of school uniform, late or absent.
