NB: All students who are vying to perform at this year's Te Mana Kuratahi National competition are required to be present for all wānanga and after-school practices. The overnight stay is to help our kapa prepare for our four-day trip to Whakatū-Nelson.

Kai details:

Each student will need to bring \$10 cash only to each live-in. Please hand in to Mā Koti (no online payments). No potluck will be required.

What to bring:

- blanket, pillow, sheet (*Please wash bedding before/after each live-in)
- 2 changes of comfortable clothes
- sports shoes / sliders
- pyjamas
- towel
- warm jacket
- toiletries – soap, shampoo, toothbrush etc
- water bottle (named)
- own practice poi (girls)
- phones must be signed in/out at the Tari as per normal school protocol
(*There will be no access to these during live-ins)

Finally, we ask that parent contact during the wānanga is kept to our drop offs / pick-ups only going forward. Practices are closed sessions to help our kapa stay focussed.
